ENTRY LEVEL

The BSC Entry Level Award in Workplace Hazard Awareness is completely free to all schools and colleges in the UK.

- Accredited in the Qualifications and Credit Framework and approved for learners aged 18 and under.
- Fits neatly into existing programmes of study such as ASDAN, PHSE and work-related learning.
- Contributes to school performance figures (3.5 points).

HOW IT WORKS

- Receive a free teacher resource pack from the British Safety Council.
- Deliver the learning and collate the portfolios (6-8 hours). The portfolio of evidence can be presented using the structured evidence sheets or in the form of posters, annotated photographs, PowerPoint presentations, audio file or DVD.
- Submit all candidate work to the British Safety Council for external marking.
- Receive results and qualification certificates within eight weeks.
- Receive a framed certificate recognising your commitment to educating young people about health and safety in the workplace.

The BSC Level 1 Award in Health and Safety at Work is a progression route from, or alternative to, the Entry Level Award in Workplace Hazard Awareness.

- Accredited in the Qualifications and Credit Framework and approved for learners aged 18 and under.
- Fits neatly into existing programmes of study such as ASDAN, PHSE and work-related learning.
- Contributes to school performance figures (6.3 points).

HOW IT WORKS

- Register to deliver the BSC Level 1 completely free of charge.
- Prepare your students for the 40-question multiple choice examination using the free learning materials supplied by the British Safety Council (6-8 hours).
- Order an unlimited number of free examinations.
- Invigilate the examinations and return the answer forms for marking.
- Receive results and qualification certificates within five working days.
- Receive a framed certificate recognising your commitment to educating young people about health and safety in the workplace.
